## **Three Step Spot Removal**

It never fails – as soon as you have your carpet cleaned, someone is going to spill on it, usually somewhere near the center of the room. Don't panic and don't wait.

Spot removal requires immediate action to prevent the spot from becoming a stain. Here are three simple steps for carpet spot removal of the most common household spills.



- 1. Squeegee and Blot up as much of the spill as you can with a clean absorbent cloth before adding any water or cleaning solution. Why? Adding liquid can cause the spot to bleed, deepen and spread.
- 2. Spray a cleaning solution to an absorbent cloth and rub into the spot. This will allow more of the spill to transfer to the cloth. We recommend a non-toxic, all-natural carpet cleaning solution. Avoid using a sudsy cleaner, such as dish or laundry detergent. This can leave a sticky residue, causing quick re-soiling.
- 3. If the spot remains, spray a cleaning solution sparingly to the spot. Rub it in with your finger or a brush. Then blot with an absorbent cloth, like cotton terry towel. Repeat if necessary.
